**BOARD ISSUES FINAL ORDER**

At its meeting on September 13, 2007 the Ohio State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Surveyors suspended the Professional Engineer registration of **Steven C. Porpora, P.E. of Akron, Ohio** for three (3) months, with that suspension stayed pending compliance with conditions ordered by the Board.

In August 2006, Mr. Porpora pled guilty to one felony count of Domestic Violence in Summit County Common Pleas Court. On December 19, 2006 Mr. Porpora notified the Board of his felony conviction. On June 8, 2007 the Board, through its Hearing Examiner, conducted an adjudication hearing concerning Steven C. Porpora, a resident of Akron, Ohio. On September 13, 2007 the Board suspended Mr. Porpora's registration as a Professional Engineer for three (3) months for violations of Ohio Revised Code Section 4733.20 (A) (4) and (5) and Ohio Administrative Code Sections 4733-35-07 (D) and 4733-35-08, with that suspension stayed on the following conditions:

- Mr. Porpora's professional engineer registration is placed on probation for one (1) year beginning with the effective date of the Board's Order. The terms of the probation shall be that Mr. Porpora not be convicted of any felonies and misdemeanors during that time, other than offenses such as traffic, that are minor misdemeanors.
- Mr. Porpora pay a \$250.00 fine within thirty (30) days of the issuance of the Board's Order.
